

It was a great honour to have **Sir Les** be RA this week in Hannibal's absence. Sir Les ran a quick but exciting circle, to ensure that the pack could get into the Diggers club before it shut the kitchen down.

The well-known Identity Des Renford MBE (1927-1999) was a renowned Australian marathon swimmer. He was inducted into the Sport Australia Hall of Fame in 1998. He was never trained by "Dick Caine" of Carrs Park because his squad of girls wanted "Dick" for themselves. They refused to share their "Dick" to outsiders.



However, Des successfully swam the English Channel 19 times from 19 attempts.

This feat remains an epic achievement in Australian sporting history. In the 1970s he held the title of King of the Channel;- even without the help "Dick"!

His rivalry with two Poms, Kevin Murphy and Mike Read, have become part of the folklore of the sport. In 1977, Des and Kevin agreed to three races against one another.

Kevin won the first – 10 miles in shark cages in Sydney Harbour.

Des won the second – an English Channel crossing.

The third and last race, was to swim the length of “Loch Ness” where the water temperature gets to near freezing.

Des was pulled from the freezing water after six and a half hours and with no “Dick” in sight. He was suffering from hypothermia and missing genitals!

He was taken to hospital where a team of local Scottish Harriettes managed locate his genitalia and caressed them back into his scrotum. Although Kevin went on another two and a half hours, he also failed to complete the course.
