- He also coached Paramatta and Cronulla after he retired.
- When he coached Cronulla in the late 70s he would take players along sandhills north of Wanda (not there now) – he was in his mid-40s and he was leading the way – players could not keep up with him.
- Made an Immortal last years – 20 years too late.
