Waverton

- Named in 1929 after the Waverton Estate in the area, which was named after a village in England.

- Very small suburb – an area of less than 1 square kilometre – only 3,000 residents
- Famous for the Balls Head Coal Loader
- Coal was shipped to Sydney from Wollongong area and the Hunter Valley from mid 1800's right up to 1970's, for the production of town gas in Sydney Town, for fuel for steamships, to fuel industrial and Hospital Boilers
- Balls Head Coal Loader opened in 1920, and operated right through to the 1990's
- Coal was unloaded from ships by cranes, dumped in a big stockpile, then into skips below the stockpile then pulled by cable to the next wharf to load onto another ship to transport the coal to all parts of Australia
- We ran through the tunnel the Skips used
- Average house price \$2.0 million

"Um... The heart.."

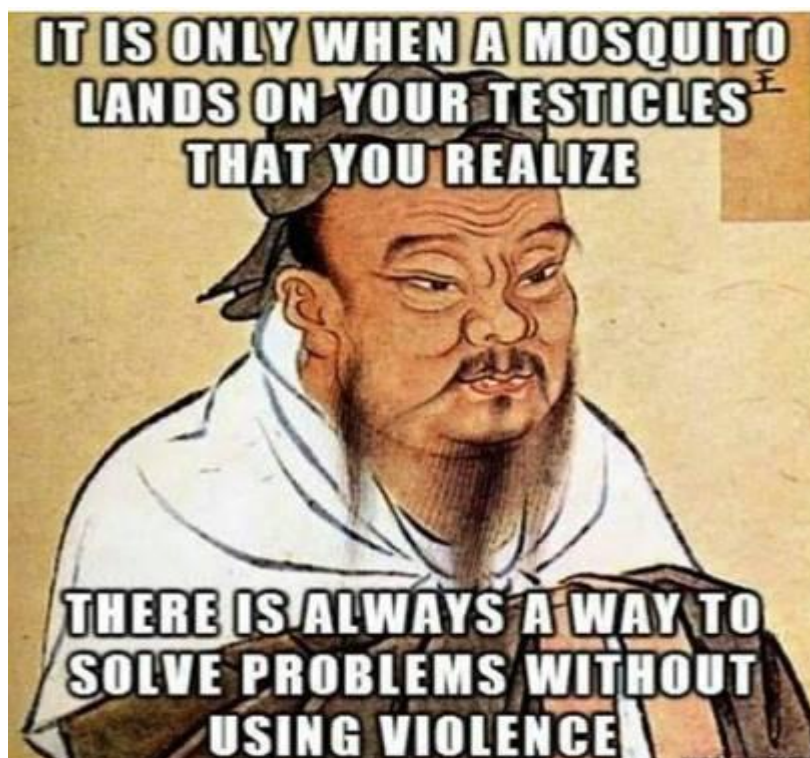
