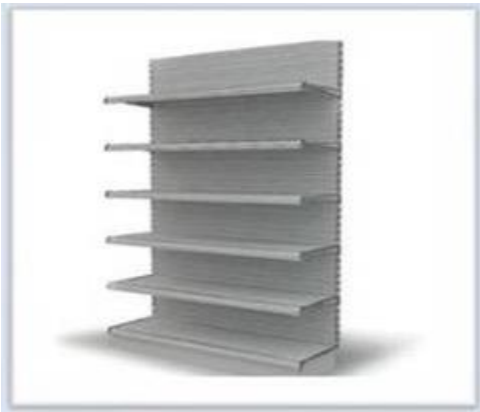
Two obnoxious businessmen in a new shopping mall.....
