Run Report

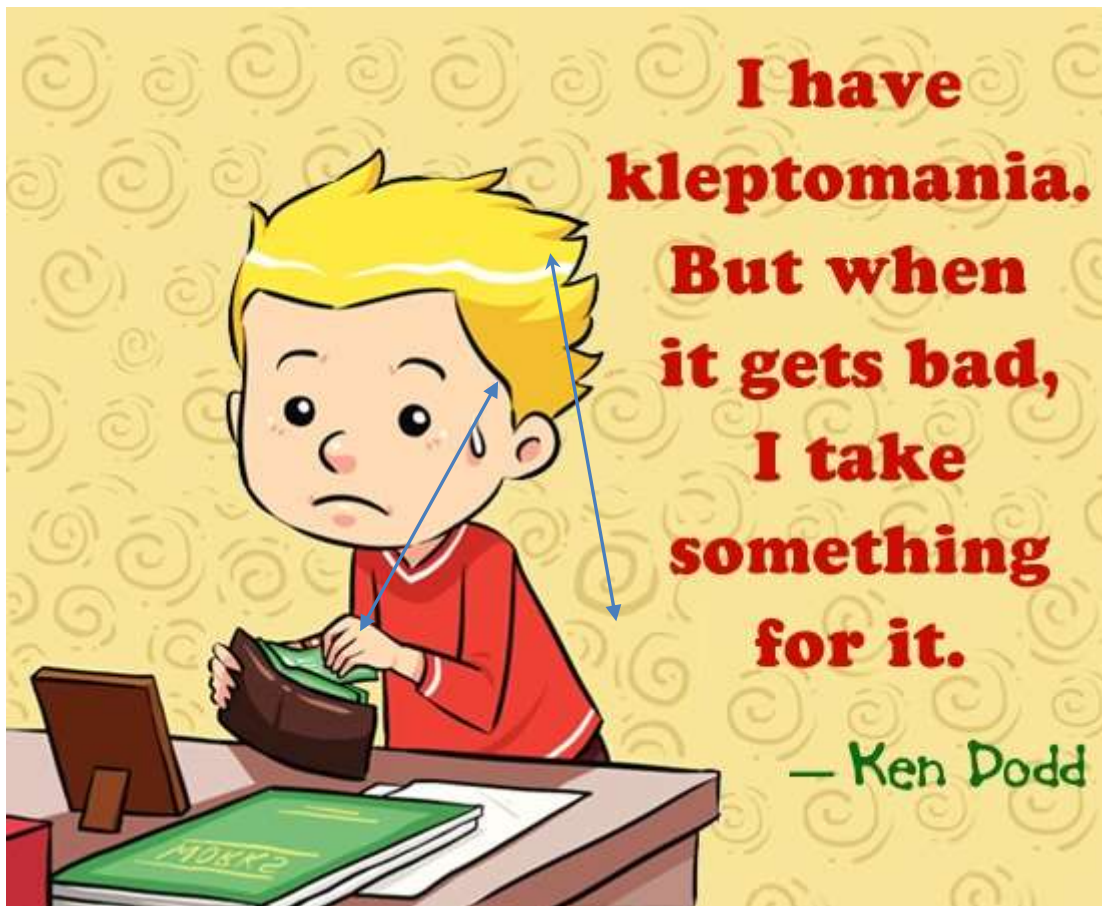
